03 NETPAY Mobile Application



THE APP

Log In

On the sign in page, the merchant will sign in with his merchant ID and password.

The app will send the phones' ID (IMEI) to the Netpay system which in response, will create an activation code.



THE APP

Activation

The unique activation code will be sent via SMS to the merchant's phone.

The merchant will then enter the activation code and the system will check the correlation between the code and the IMEI.

This will enable Netpay to control the merchant's terminals.



THE APP

Menu Screen

On the menu screen the merchant can choose between starting a new payment process and reviewing his payment history.

The history function enables the merchant to go over the last transactions made throw the mobile terminal, this will help the merchant to follow up and send out receipts.



THE APP

New Payment

On the payment screen the merchant will determine the payment details such as:

Payment amount

Payment details – what was the purpose of the purchase.

Presets – the merchant could predetermine 3 payment presets that, with the touch of a button, will allow him to move to the next step.



THE APP

Swipe card

After the merchant defines the payment details, he will be asked to swipe the card using the Netpay card swiper.

The combination of the Netpay mobile app and card swiper allows the merchant to send through all the details required for a 'card present' transaction.



THE APP

Manual Input

In cases where the merchant is not able to swipe the card, the merchant will be able to manually input the card's details. The merchant will then be asked to take a photo of the card to prove that the card was present at the moment of the payment.



THE APP

Personal Info

The next step is filling in the card holder's details, the required fields could be predetermined by Netpay or the merchant.

The client information fields will be used at the end of the process, in order to send a payment confirmation either via email or SMS.

THE APP

Signature

After making sure all the payment details are correct, the last step is for the card holder to sign for the transaction and to send the payment.

After the payment is sent for processing, the merchant will receive one of two messages:

Payment Review

The payment review page includes all details that are relevant to the transaction.

After reviewing the payment and acknowledging the information, the merchant is just one step away from finishing the transaction.

The information on this page will be used in the history page for the merchants' convenience.





THE APP

Payment Approved

After making sure all the payment details are correct, the last step is for the card holder to sign for the transaction and to send the payment.
